Fees, Disbursements and Payment

Fees

The basis of my fees is dependent of the number of documents and the type of document that you need to notarise. My notarial fees are charged on a per document basis. Complex notarial services will be charged on my hourly rate. However, I will assess the extent of your notarial requirements and offer a fixed quote. I am not VAT registered and I will not charge VAT when I provide a costs quotation for my services.

I will advise you about your potential cost total from the start.

Disbursements

If your requested notarial services incurred costs from third parties, I would add this cost to your fee total. These costs may be in relation applying for legalisation of a documents or courier fees. Any relevant disbursement will have to be agreed and paid for in advance before I make any payment to third parties in respect of your notarial transaction.
